Effective July 1, 2014, the department shall test 6 all applicants for a deputy sheriff position to determine the 7 applicant's psychological fitness for the position. 8 department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to implement 9 this section." 10 SECTION 2. (a) The department of public safety shall: 11 (1)Establish a budget; and 12 Develop and execute an implementation plan; (2) to provide for the department's use of electric quns, as that 13 term is defined in section 134-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, in 14 15 accordance with the provisions of section 134-16, Hawaii Revised
