A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH CORPS LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that many residents of SECTION 1. 2 Hawaii are increasingly unable to obtain timely and appropriate 3 health care due to shortages of primary health care providers in the State. These shortages threaten the health of Hawaii's 4 5 residents and affect state health care costs. These shortages have pushed the federal government to designate a number of 7 areas in the State, particularly rural areas, as medically underserved areas, health professional shortage areas, or as 8 9 having medically underserved populations. The legislature further finds that the increasingly high 10 11 cost of health care professional education requires individuals to seek out the higher incomes that allow them to repay their 12 13 However, these higher incomes are usually in student loans. specialty care in urban areas, not in the areas of greatest need 14 Since September 1, 2012, a total of sixteen 15 in Hawaii. physicians and nurse practitioners have received loan repayment 16 to work in health professions shortage areas in Hawaii and are 17 18 still serving these communities through a loan repayment program SB2058 SD2 LRB 14-1721.doc

- 4 The purpose of this Act is to fund the Hawaii health corps'
- 5 Hawaii rural health care provider loan repayment program under
- 6 the John A. Burns school of medicine of the University of Hawaii
- 7 to provide loan repayment for physicians, physician assistants,
- 8 nurse practitioners, psychologists, and social workers who agree
- 9 to work in a federally designated health professions shortage
- 10 area or an area of Hawaii found to be underserved.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
- 14 the implementation and administration of the Hawaii health
- 15 corps' Hawaii rural health care provider loan repayment program.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the John A. Burns
- 17 school of medicine of the University of Hawaii for the purposes
- 18 of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
