A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS PERMIT FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the fireworks 2 display permit fee, which authorizes licensed pyrotechnicians to conduct outdoor aerial fireworks and indoor fireworks for 3 4 theatrical purposes, has remained the same for thirteen years, 5 while the cost to process, review, and approve the permits has increased. 6 7 The purpose of this Act is to raise the fireworks display permit fee from \$110 to \$300. 8 9 Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended to read as follows: "§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the 11 purchase and use of: 12 13 (1)Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers 14 upon payment of a fee of \$25;
- 15 (2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles
 16 pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon
 17 payment of a fee of [\$\frac{\$110}{}\;] \frac{\$300}{}\; and

1	(3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section
2	132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time
3	other than during the periods prescribed in section
4	132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of \$25."
5	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
