A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The department of public safety, with the
- 2 assistance of the department of accounting and general services,
- 3 the department of business, economic development, and tourism,
- 4 or any other department as needed, shall build and operate a new
- 5 two thousand to three thousand bed correctional facility
- 6 designed to house medium-security inmates. The department of
- 7 public safety shall explore the possibility of establishing
- 8 private-financing partnerships for this purpose.
- 9 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 10 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 12 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
- 13 for the purpose of the building and operation of a new two
- 14 thousand bed correctional facility designed to house medium-
- 15 security inmates.
- 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the SB LRB 14-0547.doc



- 1 building and operation of a new two thousand to three thousand
- 2 bed correctional facility designed to house medium-security
- 3 inmates.
- 4 SECTION 4. The appropriations made for the capital
- 5 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
- 6 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
- 7 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
- 8 of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
