BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the
- 2 definition of programmatic agreement to accurately reflect what
- 3 is required in the phased review of certain projects by the
- 4 department of land and natural resources by specifying the
- 5 federal law pursuant to which programmatic agreements must be
- 6 developed.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by amending the definition of "programmatic agreement"
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 ""Programmatic agreement" means a document that sets forth
- 11 the terms of a formal, legally binding agreement and establishes
- 12 a process for consultation $[\tau]$ and review $[\tau]$ and compliance with
- 13 federal laws.] pursuant to section 106 of the National Historic
- 14 Preservation Act and its implementing regulations."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
