### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 149A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$149A- Use of glyphosate prohibited. No product
- 5 containing any amount of glyphosate shall be sold, transferred,
- 6 distributed, or used within the State until July 1, 2019."
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 149A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 9 and to read as follows:
- ""Glyphosate" means a synthetic compound that is a non-
- 11 selective systemic herbicide, also known as N-(phosphonomethyl)
- 12 glycine with a chemical formula of C<sub>3</sub>H<sub>8</sub>NO<sub>5</sub>P."
- 13 SECTION 3. (a) There shall be established within the
- 14 department of health for administrative purposes a glyphosate
- 15 working group.
- 16 (b) The working group shall consist of the following
- 17 members:

3	travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties.		
4	(e) The members of the working group shall submit a report		
5	of the working group's findings and recommendations, including		
6	any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than		
7	twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of		
8	2019.		
9	(f) The glyphosate working group shall cease to exist on		
10	June 30, 2019.
