BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§103D- Single-serving bottled water; prohibition on		
5	using state funds to purchase. (a) Notwithstanding sections		
6	103D-102(b)(3), (b)(4)(H), and (b)(4)(L) and 103D-305, no state		
7	agency shall use state funds for the purchase of single-serving		
8	bottled water, except as provided in subsection (b).		
9	(b) The following circumstances shall constitute		
10	exceptions to subsection (a):		
11	(1) Public safety emergencies, investigations, and		
12	extended deployments or activations of the office of		
13	hazard evaluation and emergency response of the		
14	department of health or the department of defense;		
15	(2) Situations where there is high risk of cross-		
16	contamination with non-potable or contaminated water;		
17	<u>or</u>		

1	(3)	Situations where there are no reasonable alternatives
2		to bottled water, such as large public events and when
3		large quantities of water may need to be distributed
4		for health and safety reasons.
5	(c)	For purposes of this section:
6	<u>"Stat</u>	te agency" means a state agency, office, or department.
7	<u>"Stat</u>	te funds" means any money deposited into or drawn from
8	the state	treasury or any special or trust fund of the State.
9	"State fur	nds" includes any money appropriated by the State and
10	transferre	ed to any state agency that is used by the state
11	agency, in	whole or in part, to purchase goods or services."
