A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE STATE CAPITOL REFLECTING POOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The state capitol building is on the National Register of Historic Places and the state register of historic
- 3 places. The waterproof membrane under the reflecting pools has
- 4 not been replaced since the state capitol building was opened on
- 5 March 16, 1969. The reflecting pools are periodically fed by
- ${f 6}$ brackish water from wells. The brackish water has a propensity
- 7 to leak into the underlying chamber level of the state capitol
- 8 building, resulting in damage to offices and corrosion to
- 9 electrical conduits and to air conditioning ducts.
- 10 The legislature finds that the reflecting pools, which
- 11 total approximately 77,000 square feet, have long been plagued
- 12 by persistent algae growth and have become stagnant because of
- 13 inadequate water circulation and no filtration. The reflecting
- 14 pools cannot be abandoned or neglected because the state
- 15 historic preservation division deems the reflecting pools to be
- 16 a "character-defining element" of the state capitol.

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         The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to the
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    department of accounting and general services for capital
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    improvements to the state capitol reflecting pools.
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                     The director of finance is authorized to issue
         SECTION 2.
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    general obligation bonds in the sum of $1,000,000 or so much
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    thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
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    as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
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    for the design for the replacement of the state capitol
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    reflecting pools bottom; waterproof membrane; circulation
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    system; filtration system, including but not limited to natural
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    filtration methods; and other improvements.
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         The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
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    accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
                     The director of finance is authorized to issue
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    general obligation bonds in the sum of $10,541,000 or so much
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    thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
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    as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015.
    for the construction of the replacement of the state capitol
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    reflecting pools bottom; waterproof membrane; circulation
    system; filtration system, including but not limited to natural
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filtration methods; and other improvements.

1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 2 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act. 3 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital 4 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is 5 6 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation 7 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date. 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013. 9
