BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-355, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 4 contractors, subcontractors, contract bidders, and applicants
- 5 for and recipients of grants and subsidies prohibited. (a) It
- 6 shall be unlawful for any person who enters into any contract

- 8 thereof, or any person who is subcontracted under that contract,
- 9 either for the rendition of personal services, the buying of
- 10 property, or furnishing of any material, supplies, or equipment
- 11 to the State, any of the counties, any department or agency
- 12 thereof, or for selling any land or building to the State, any
- 13 of the counties, or any department or agency thereof, if payment
- 14 for the performance of the contract or payment for material,
- 15 supplies, equipment, land, property, or building is to be made
- 16 in whole or in part from funds appropriated by the legislative
- 17 body, at any time between the execution of the contract through
- 18 the completion of the contract, to:

- 8 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 10 begun before its effective date.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
