A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The purpose of this Act is to:
2	(1)	Authorize the state fire council to set minimum
3		certification requirements for individuals, operators,
4		and contractors performing maintenance and testing of
5		portable fire extinguishers, fire protection systems,
6		and fire alarm systems;
7	(2)	Base the certifications on the adopted state fire code
8		and standards;
9	(3)	Recognize the certifications through the State; and
10	(4)	Authorize the fire council to implement statewide fire
11		and emergency responder memoranda of understanding and
12		agreements for the effective use of fire and life
13		safety resources.
14	SECT:	ION 2. Section 132-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15	amended by	y amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
16	"(C)	The state fire council may also:
17	(1)	Appoint advisory committees comprised of
18		representatives from each county fire department to
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1		assist in drafting the state fire code and
2		coordinating statewide training, data collection, and
3		contingency planning needs for firefighters; [and]
4	(2)	Advise and assist the county fire departments where
5		appropriate, may prescribe standard procedures and
6		forms relating to inspections, investigations, and
7		reporting of fires, may approve plans for cooperation
8		among the county fire departments, and may advise the
9		governor and the legislature with respect to fire
10		prevention and protection, life safety, and any other
11		functions or activities for which the various county
12		fire departments are generally responsible $[-]$;
13	(3)	Establish statewide qualifications, testing, and
14		certification, based on the adopted state fire code
15		and standards, for individuals that conduct
16		maintenance testing of fire extinguishers and fire
17		protection and fire alarm systems; provided that
18		certification fees shall be determined by the county
19		fire departments; and
20	(4)	Coordinate and implement statewide fire and emergency
21		responder memoranda of understanding and agreements to

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1	promote the effective use of fire and life safety
2	resources."
3	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
5	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
