BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

5	vehicle commonly known as a pickup truck while the vehicle is i

7	vehicle with a passenger seated in the bed or load-carrying are

9	(1) There is no seating available in the cab of the		
10	vehicle;		
11	(2) The side racks of the vehicle are securely attached		
12	and the tailboard or tailgate is securely closed;		
13	(3) Every passenger in the bed or load-carrying area of

15	attempt to control unlashed cargo.		
16	(b) This section shall not apply to persons or		
17	corporations operating a business or businesses that serve the

Pickup Truck Passengers; Vehicle Safety

Description:

Prohibits operation of a pickup truck with a passenger in the bed or load-carrying area on interstate freeways, except in life-threatening emergency situations. Permits the operation of a pickup truck with a passenger in the bed or load-carrying area when driving on a public street, road, or highway other than an interstate freeway at a speed of no more than 35 miles per hour. Prohibits individuals from hanging on to the outside of any vehicle other than the enclosed portion intended for passengers. Increases the fine for violations.
