A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KANEOHE BAY REGIONAL COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 200D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended as follows: 2 3 1. By amending subsection (c) to read: 4 The director of health; [the superintendent of 5 education; two representatives] a representative of the department of land and natural resources[, including one from 6 the] division of boating and ocean recreation [and one from]; 7 8 the administrator of the aquatic resources division; the 9 commanding officer of the Kaneohe Marine Corps Air Station; and the director of the office of planning; [and the director of 10 11 business, economic development, and tourism; or their designated representatives shall serve as ex officio nonvoting 12 members of the council. Additionally, the council may designate 13 representatives of other appropriate agencies as ex officio 14 15 nonvoting members of the council."

10	review and evaluate the provisions of section 200D-3, Hawaii		
11	Revised Statutes, to determine whether its powers, duties, and		
12	functions remain applicable and relevant and if changes to its		
13	mission a	nd functions are required.	
14	(b)	The Kaneohe bay regional council shall submit a report	
15	of its fi	ndings and recommendations, including the results of	
16	its review and evaluation pursuant to subsection (a), and any		
17	proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty		
18	days prio	r to the convening of the regular session of 2015.

21	SECT	ION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
