RELATING TO PUBLIC ORDER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 711-1110.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:	
3	"§ 71	1-1110.9 Violation of privacy in the first degree.
4	(1) A pe	rson commits the offense of violation of privacy in the
5	first degree if, except in the execution of a public duty or as	
6	authorized by $law[-]$:	
7	<u>(a)</u>	[the] The person intentionally or knowingly installs
8		or uses, or both, in any private place, without
9		consent of the person or persons entitled to privacy
10		therein, any device for observing, recording,
11		amplifying, or broadcasting another person in a stage
12		of undress or sexual activity in that $place[-]$; or
13	<u>(b)</u>	The person knowingly discloses an image of another
14		identifiable person in the nude as defined by section
15		712-1210, or of another identifiable person engaging
16		in sexual activity, without the depicted person's
17		consent, with intent to substantially harm the
18		depicted person with respect to that person's health,

1	safety, business, calling, career, financial
2	condition, reputation, or personal relationships.
3	This section shall not apply to images voluntarily
4	disclosed in public or commercial settings.
5	(2) Violation of privacy in the first degree is a class C
6	felony. In addition to any penalties the court may impose, the
7	court may order the destruction of any recording made in
8	violation of this section."
9	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties tha
10	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
11	begun before its effective date.
12	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
