BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 657-1.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:		
3	"(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, an action		
4	for recovery of damages based on physical, psychological, or		
5	other injury or condition suffered by an individual arising from		
6	sexual assault in the first and second degrees or continuous		
7	sexual assault of a minor under the age of fourteen years may be		
8	commenced at any time; provided that no action for recovery of		
9	damages based on physical, psychological, or other injury or		
10	condition suffered by a minor arising from [the] any other		
11	sexual abuse of the minor that constituted or would have		
12	constituted a criminal offense under part V or VI of chapter 707		
13	by any person shall be commenced against the person who		
14	committed the act of sexual abuse more than:		
15	(1) Eight years after the eighteenth birthday of the minor		
16	or the person who committed the act of sexual abuse		
17	attains the age of majority, whichever occurs later;
