A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERSONAL INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 195, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2013, is scheduled to sunset on July 31, 2014.
- 3 The legislature further finds that Act 195 was intended to help
- 4 ensure that age-restricted goods and services are not purchased
- 5 by underage individuals by specifying that the machine-readable
- 6 zone of an individual's Hawaii identification card or driver's
- 7 license may be scanned to verify age, if the business has a
- 8 reasonable doubt of the individual having reached the minimum
- 9 age required for purchasing the age-restricted goods or
- 10 services.
- 11 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to further ensure
- 12 that age-restricted goods and services are not purchased by
- 13 underage individuals by repealing the sunset date of Act 195,
- 14 Session Laws of Hawaii 2013.
- 15 SECTION 2. Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, is
- 16 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval[+
- 18 provided that on July 31, 2014, this Act shall be repealed and





- 1 section 487J-6(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted
- 2 in the form in which it read on the day prior to the effective
- 3 date of this Act]."
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Identification Card; Driver's License; Personal Information; Age-restricted Goods or Services

Description:

Repeals the sunset date of Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, making permanent a business's ability to scan an individual's driver's license or Hawaii identification card to verify age when providing age-restricted goods or services, if the business has a reasonable doubt of the individual having reached the minimum age required for purchasing the age-restricted goods or services.
