

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HURRICANE RELIEF FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431P, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§431P- Refund of Money. (a) Any owner of eligible
- 5 property as defined in section 431P-1 who, within ninety days
- 6 after the effective date of this Act, submits to the Hawaii
- 7 Hurricane Relief Fund proof of payment as defined in section
- 8 431P-1 of special mortgage recording fees as established by this
- 9 chapter, shall receive a full refund from the hurricane reserve
- 10 trust fund of those fees.
- 11 (b) Any owner of eligible property as defined in section
- 12 431P-1 who, within ninety days after the effective date of this
- 13 Act, submits to the Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund proof of
- 14 payment as defined in section 431P-1 of the amount paid in
- 15 policy premiums for hurricane insurance coverage issued by the
- 16 Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund, either directly or through a
- 17 servicing carrier, shall receive a prorated refund from the
- 18 hurricane reserve trust fund of those premiums paid.

1	(c) The pro rata percentage in subsection (b) of this			
2	section shall be calculated as provided in this section. After			
3	the ninety day deadline for submitting refund claims has			
4	expired, and all valid claims under subsection (a) of this			
5	section have been paid, the accumulated total net income left			
6	the hurricane reserve trust fund, less \$1,000,000, shall be			
7	distributed among the claimants as follows. If the funds			
8	available for distribution are sufficient, all persons with			
9	valid claims under subsection (b) shall be refunded the total			
10	amount claimed under subsection (b) for which proof of payment			
11	is provided. If sufficient funds are not available to refund			
12	all claimants in full, each claimant shall be assigned a			
13	percentage equal to the amount of policy premiums for which that			
14	claimant has provided proof of payment under subsection (b),			
15	divided by the total sum of policy premiums for which proof of			
16	payment has been provided by all claimants under subsection			
17	(b). Each claimant shall then be refunded that claimant's			
18	assigned percentage of the total funds available for			
19	distribution under this subsection.			
20	(d) Refunds under this section shall be issued no later			
21	than sixty days after the ninety day deadline for submission of			
22	claims established in subsections (a) and (b) of this section.

1	Any refun	d to which a property owner is entitled under this	
2	section,	and which is not paid by the date required by this	
3	subsectio	n, shall accrue interest on the amount unpaid at a rate	
4	equal to	the prime rate for each calendar quarter plus two per	
5	cent, but	in no event exceeding twelve per cent per year, until	
6	it is pai	d. As used in this subsection, "prime rate" means the	
7	prime rat	e as posted in the Wall Street Journal on the first	
8	business	day of the month preceding the calendar quarter."	
9	SECT	ION 2. Section 431P-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
10	amended b	y adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted	
11	and to read as follows:		
12	" <u>"</u> Pr	oof of payment" includes any one of the following:	
13	(1)	A copy of the owner of eligible property's mortgage	
14		closing statement showing the amount paid for a	
15		special mortgage recording fee;	
16	(2)	A copy of the page or pages from the owner of eligible	
17		property's homeowner's policy packets showing the	
18		coverage limits, deductible, servicing carrier, and	
19		policy premiums for the Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund	
20		issued hurricane insurance, for each year the policy	
21		was in force;	



1	(3)	A copy of a cancelled check for special mortgage
2		recording fees paid;
3	(4)	A copy of a cancelled check for policy premiums paid
4		for hurricane insurance issued by the Hawaii Hurricane
5		Relief Fund;
6	(5)	Records from a financial institution proving payment
7		by an owner of eligible property of special mortgage
8		recording fees or of policy premiums for hurricane
9		insurance issued by the Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund;
10		<u>or</u>
11	(6)	Any other proof satisfactory to the officers of the
12		Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund that an owner of eligible
13		property paid special mortgage recording fees or
14		policy premiums for hurricane insurance issued by the
15		Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund."
16	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
