# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FACILITIES FUNDING FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that facilities funding 2 has been a long-standing issue for charter schools nationally 3 and locally. In Hawaii, start-up charter schools have paid the 4 costs of their facilities from operational funds. However, Act 5 159, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, authorized the state public 6 charter school commission to request facilities funding as part 7 of its annual budget request to the director of finance 8 beginning with the 2014-2015 fiscal year.

9 The legislature further finds that the state public charter 10 school commission is currently implementing a facilities pilot 11 project for the allocation of funds to various charter schools 12 for small-scale facilities projects based, in part, on the need 13 and performance of the charter schools. The commission has 14 currently allocated \$680,000 of federal impact aid to this pilot 15 program.

16 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 17 state public charter school commission to support its facilities 18 pilot project.



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1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the state public charter school commission to allocate to charter 4 5 schools for facilities projects based, in part, on the need and performance of the charter schools. 6 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state public 8 charter school commission for the purposes of this Act. 9 SECTION 3. The state public charter school commission 10 shall report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior 11 to the convening of each regular session, beginning with the 12 regular session of 2015, for the duration of the state public 13 charter school commission's pilot project on the use of the 14 funds appropriated under this Act and the results of the state 15 public charter school commission's facilities pilot project.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
