A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELDERLY HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is an increasing need for elderly housing, and that the need will continue to grow as the baby boomer generation reaches
- 4 retirement age. Hawaii's elderly population exceeds the
- 5 national average. Consequently, the State must have a
- ${f 6}$ heightened awareness of the aging population's needs, including
- 7 the increasing demand for affordable elderly housing. Elderly
- 8 housing units require special features such as emergency call
- 9 buttons, community facilities for congregate activities, and
- 10 support services to assist the elders with aging at home.
- 11 Currently the Hawaii public housing authority does not
- 12 operate any elderly-only facilities due to stringent federal
- 13 requirements that control the conversion of existing housing to
- 14 elderly-only housing. The legislature finds that adding an
- 15 elderly housing complex would allow the Hawaii public housing
- 16 authority to increase housing inventory and support operational
- 17 costs through rent revenue and potential federal subsidy.

- The purpose of this Act, therefore, is to create needed 1 2 housing for the elderly by appropriating funds to the Hawaii
- 3 public housing authority to establish an elderly-only housing
- complex at their School street location. 4
- 5 There is appropriated out of the general SECTION 2.
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$60,000,000 or so 6
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
- 8 the redevelopment of the Hawaii public housing authority's
- 9 administrative offices located on School street and the design
- 10 and construction of an elderly-only housing complex at the same
- 11 location.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii public
- housing authority for the purposes of this Act. 13
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
