A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§321- Packages and packaging containing metals. (a)
5	Beginning January 1, 2015, no person or legal entity shall
6	manufacture, sell, or distribute any package or packaging
7	containing levels of lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent
8	chromium present in excess of one hundred parts per million by
9	weight.
10	(b) This section shall apply only to lead, cadmium,
11	mercury, and hexavalent chromium that has been intentionally
12	introduced as an element during manufacturing or distribution.
13	(c) As used in this section:
14	"Package" means the immediate container or wrapping in
15	which any substance or item is contained for sale or use in the

- 1 "Packaging" means any material used to surround, brace, 2 cushion, coat, or hold any substance or item for use or sale in 3 the State." SECTION 2. Chapter 323F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 6 and to read as follows: 7 "§323F-Procurement of vinyl intravenous solution bags and tubing prohibited. (a) Beginning January 1, 2015, the 8 9 corporation shall not purchase or use any vinyl intravenous 10 solution bags or vinyl tubing for use in any health care 11 application. 12 (b) As used in this section: 13 "Vinyl intravenous solution bags" means intravenous 14 solution bags containing any amount of polyvinyl chloride 15 plastic for use in health care. "Vinyl tubing" means tubing containing any amount of 16 17 polyvinyl chloride plastic for use in health care." SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 18 19 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 20 begun before its effective date. 21 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
