- SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1
- amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2
- and to read as follows: 3
- Head injuries. Any person diagnosed with a 4 "§321-
- concussion shall not engage in contact sports for thirty days. 5
- Any person diagnosed with a concussion shall be cleared by a 6
- licensed physician prior to playing contact sports following the 7
- thirty-day waiting period. For the purposes of this section, 8
- the term "contact sports" means a sport that involves physical 9
- contact between players as part of normal play." 10
- SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 11
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 12
