#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the state building
- 2 code council was created in 2007 to review and adopt current,
- 3 nationally recognized building codes and standards for the
- 4 State. However, the staff and operating expenses of the council
- 5 have never been funded, thereby limiting the effectiveness of
- 6 the work of the nine voting members.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to add building industry and
- 8 trade representatives to the council membership, allow
- 9 staggering of the code adoption, define and clarify terminology,
- 10 ensure the laws governing building contractors do not conflict
- 11 with part II, chapter 107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and
- 12 appropriate funds to the department of accounting and general
- 13 services for the council's operating costs.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 107-21 Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended as follows:
- 1. By adding two new definitions to be appropriately
- 17 inserted and to read:



1 ""Codes and standards" means nationally recognized minimum 2 requirements that shall be met for design and construction to safeguard life, property, and the general welfare. 3 4 "Hawaii state building codes" means the building codes and standards that the state building code council adopts under 5 6 section 107-24." 7 2. By amending the definition of "hurricane resistive criteria" to read: 8 9 "Hurricane [resistive] resistant criteria" means the design 10 criteria for enhanced hurricane protection areas that are 11 capable of withstanding a five hundred-year hurricane event, as 12 developed by the state department of defense for public shelter and residential safe room design criteria." 13 14 SECTION 3. Section 107-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 15 16 "(a) There is established a state building code council. The council shall be placed within the department of accounting 17 18 and general services for administrative purposes only. 19 council shall consist of [nine] eleven voting members and one 20 nonvoting member, who shall be the comptroller or the 21 comptroller's designee. The council members shall serve four-

4	(b) [Six] Seven voting members shall constitute a quorum.		
5	The chairperson of the council shall be elected annually from		
6	among its members by a majority vote of the members of the		
7	council."		
8	SECTION 4. Section 107-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
9	amended to read as follows:

11	(a) The council shall appoint, exempt from chapters 76 and 89,		
12	an executive director, who shall serve at the pleasure of the		
13	council, and who shall have administrative abilities and

15	building industry. The council shall also appoint, exempt from		
16	chapters 76 and 89, an executive assistant, who shall have		
17	experience in statutory and administrative rulemaking		
18	processes[+] to assist in carrying out the duties of the council		
19	under section 107-24. Other staff may be appointed but shall		
20	not be exempt from chapters 76 and 89.		
21	(b) The budgetary requirements for conducting meetings,		
22	training, travel, and other related responsibilities of the

- 2 assistant, and other staff, shall be included in the budget of
- 3 the department of accounting and general services."
- 4 SECTION 5. Section 107-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 "[+]\\$107-24[+] Authority and duties of the council. (a)
- 7 Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the council shall
- 8 establish [a comprehensive] the Hawaii state building [code.]
- 9 codes.
- 10 (b) The council shall appoint a subcommittee comprised of
- 11 the four council members representing county building officials,
- 12 whose duty shall be to recommend any necessary or desirable
- 13 state amendments to the [model] codes[-] and standards
- 14 identified in section 107-25. Any recommended state amendments
- 15 shall require the unanimous agreement of the subcommittee.
- 16 (c) The council shall designate the staggering of the
- 17 adoption of the codes and standards to be adopted, amended, and
- 18 updated. The frequency of the adoption of any code or standard
- 19 shall not exceed every six years. Any recommended staggering of
- 20 adoptions shall be based on a review and evaluation of the
- 21 utility of each code and standard identified in section 107-25
- when each edition is published.

- 2 technical expertise committees, which may include council
- 3 members.
- 4 [\frac{(d)}{d}] (e) The council shall consult with general building
- 5 contractor associations and building trade associations to
- 6 gather information and recommendations on construction practices
- 7 and training relevant to building codes and standards.
- **8** [<del>(e)</del>] (f) The council shall review and adopt, as
- 9 appropriate, new model building codes within eighteen months of
- 10 the official publication date.
- 11 [(f)] (g) The council may make expenditures for technical
- 12 references, equipment and supplies, and other operating
- 13 expenses, and may contract for the conduct of research studies
- 14 and other technical services.
- 15  $\left[\frac{g}{g}\right]$  (h) The council  $\left[\frac{g}{g}\right]$  may provide education and
- 16 technical training and administrative assistance in the form of
- 17 services or grants at the state and county levels relating to
- 18 the implementation and enforcement of the Hawaii state building
- 19 code adopted pursuant to this part.
- 20 (i) At the end of each fiscal year, the council shall make
- 21 a written report to the governor on the council's activities,
- 22 including the codes and standards established by the council."
