RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: "§387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 3 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 4 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 5 6 than: \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 7 (1)\$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; [and] (2) 8 \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007[-]; 9 (3) \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 10 (4)\$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 11 (5) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; and 12 (6) \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018. 13 (7) The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to 14 (b) be increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 15 16 than: (1) 25 cents;

Labor; Minimum Wage; Tip Credit

Description:

Increases minimum wage rate to \$7.75 per hour beginning on 1/1/15, \$8.50 per hour beginning on 1/1/16, \$9.25 per hour beginning on 1/1/17, and \$10.10 per hour beginning on 1/1/18. Increases the tip credit to 50 cents per hour beginning on 1/1/15, 75 cents per hour beginning on 1/1/16, and \$1 per hour beginning on 1/1/17 if the gross amount the employee receives in wages and tips is at least 250 per cent of the poverty level for each calendar year based upon the United States Department of Health and Human Services poverty guidelines for Hawaii. Effective 7/1/14. (SB2609 HD1)
