Chapter 487, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§487- Electronic device location data collected or 5 used by businesses. (a) No business shall acquire, aggregate, analyze, sell, or otherwise use the location data of any 6 7 electronic device without first obtaining in writing the informed, affirmative consent of the owner or user of the 9 device. 10 (b) Any person who violates this section shall be subject 11 to civil penalties of not more than \$ 12 (c) As used in this section: "Business" means a sole proprietorship, partnership, 13 14 limited partnership, corporation, limited liability company, 15 association, or any other form of business entity. "Electronic device" means a device that enables access to 16
