A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "historic property" to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 ""Historic property" means any building, structure, object,
- 5 district, area, or site, including heiau and underwater site,
- 6 [which] that is over fifty years old[-]; provided that historic
- 7 property shall not include any private residence that has not
- 8 been entered, or nominated by the owner of the residence for
- 9 entry, onto the Hawaii register of historic places."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
