BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 4 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 5 6 than: \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 7 (1) \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; [and] 8 (2) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007[-]; 9 (3) 10 \$8.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; (4)\$8.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; and 11 (5) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017. 12 (6) The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to 13 (b) 14 be increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 15 than $\left[\frac{25}{2}\right]$: (1) 50 cents below the applicable minimum wage beginning 16 17 January 1, 2015;

Increases the tip credit to not less than 50 cents per hour below the applicable minimum wage beginning on 01/01/15 and 25 cents per hour below the applicable minimum wage beginning on 01/01/16 and 01/01/17.
