A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SEAT BELTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291-11.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 "(C) No person shall be guilty of violating this section 4 if: 5 (1)The person is in a motor vehicle which is not required 6 to be equipped with a seat belt assembly under any federal motor vehicle safety standard unless the 7 8 vehicle is in fact equipped with a seat belt assembly; 9 (2) The person not restrained by a seat belt assembly is 10 in a vehicle in which the number of persons exceeds 11 the number of seat belt assemblies available in the vehicle or the number of seat belt assemblies 12 13 originally installed in the vehicle, whichever is greater; provided that all available seat belt 14 15 assemblies are being used to restrain passengers; 16 (3) The person not restrained by a seat belt assembly has 17 a condition which prevents appropriate restraint by 18 the seat belt assembly; provided the condition is duly

1		certified by a physician or a physician assistant who
2		shall state the nature of the condition, as well as
3		the reason the restraint is inappropriate;
4	(4)	The person [not restrained by a seat belt assembly] is
5		operating a taxicab or other motor vehicle used in
6		performing a bona fide metered taxicab service which
7		is regulated under chapter 269 or by county ordinance
8 .		and is restrained by a seat belt assembly but is
9		carrying passengers [in the vehicle] who are
10		unrestrained by a seat belt assembly in the course of
11		performing taxicab services; [or provided that
12		appropriate signage in the English language is posted
13		in the passenger compartment of the vehicle notifying
14		passengers that state law requires the mandatory use
15		of seat belts; provided further that each adult
16		passenger who is unrestrained by a seat belt assembly
17		shall be subject to subsection (e); or
18	(5)	Otherwise exempted by rules adopted by the department
19		of transportation pursuant to chapter 91."
