RELATING TO PARKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1.
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§291-71 Designation of parking spaces for electric
- vehicles; charging system[-]; penalty. (a) Places of public 4
- accommodation with at least one hundred parking spaces available 5
- for use by the general public shall have at least one parking 6
- 7 space exclusively for electric vehicles and equipped with an
- 8 electric vehicle charging system located anywhere in the parking
- structure or lot by July 1, 2012; provided that no parking space 9
- designated for electric vehicles shall displace or reduce 10
- 11 accessible stalls required by the Americans with Disabilities
- Act Accessibility Guidelines. Spaces shall be designated, 12
- clearly marked, and the exclusive designation enforced. Owners 13
- 14 of multiple parking facilities within the State may designate
- 15 and electrify fewer parking spaces than required in one or more
- of their owned properties; provided that the scheduled 16
- 17 requirement is met for the total number of aggregate spaces on
- 18 all of their owned properties.
