A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SEAWATER AIR CONDITIONING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that seawater air
- 2 conditioning district cooling systems help to reduce the State's
- 3 dependence on fossil fuels and help its economy. The twenty-
- 4 five-thousand-ton seawater air conditioning district cooling
- 5 system under development for downtown Honolulu can potentially
- 6 reduce Oahu's dependence on imported oil.
- 7 The downtown Honolulu seawater air conditioning project
- 8 will generate millions of dollars in construction-project
- 9 spending and create a significant amount of long-term, gainful
- 10 employment. In addition, other local economic development
- 11 benefits will accrue from money that stays in the State and is
- 12 not exported outside the State to purchase oil.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to assist seawater air
- 14 conditioning district cooling systems by allowing the systems to
- 15 benefit from the State's enterprise zones program.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 209E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by amending the definition of "eligible business
- 18 activity" to read as follows:

2	(1)	Manufacture of tangible personal property, the
3		wholesale sale of tangible personal property as
4		described in section 237-4, or a service business as
5		defined in this section;
6	(2)	Production of agricultural products where the business
7		is a producer as defined in section 237-5, or the
8		processing of agricultural products, all or some of
9		which were grown within an enterprise zone;
10	(3)	Research, development, sale, or production of all
11		types of genetically-engineered medical, agricultural,
12		or maritime biotechnology products; [ex]
13	(4)	Production of electric power from wind energy for sale
14		primarily to a public utility company for resale to
15		the public[-]; or
16	<u>(5)</u>	Production of air conditioning in an area or district
17		from a seawater air conditioning cooling system."
18	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
