The temporary insurance binder shall be subject to 5 cancellation should the person fail to take, complete, and pass 6 the course for which proof was submitted to the insurer.] 7 Liability coverage provided under subsection (a)(3) shall be in 8 the form of a temporary insurance binder issued for a period of 9 not more than one-hundred eighty days from the date of learner's 10 permit issuance to a person who has a valid motorcycle or motor 11 scooter learner's permit. If the person does not obtain a 12 license pursuant to section 286-108 within the period of 13 temporary insurance coverage, the person will be required to enroll in an approved motorcycle education course in order to 14 15 continue insurance coverage beyond the one-hundred eighty day **16** limit. (c) If a person with liability coverage under subsection **17** 18 (a) (3) does not obtain a license pursuant to section 286-108 within one hundred and eighty days of the date learner's permit 19 20 issuance, a second temporary insurance binder covering a period 21 of not more than ninety days may be issued to a person who has a valid motorcycle or motor scooter learner's permit. To obtain 22

- 1 the second temporary binder, the person shall submit proof to
- 2 the insurer of the person's enrollment in an approved motorcycle
- 3 education course. The temporary insurance binder shall be
- 4 subject to cancellation should the person fail to take,
- 5 complete, and pass the course for which proof was submitted to
