BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§</u> 28	6- All-terrain vehicle; permitted use. (a) All-	
5	terrain vehicles shall be operated:		
6	(1)	As farm equipment;	
7	(2)	On a street, as defined in section 291C-1, in	
8		conjunction with the use of the all-terrain vehicle as	
9		farm equipment; and	
10	(3)	By an operator who holds a current category (3) driver	
11		license under section 286-102 or a commercial driver's	
12		license under part XIII;	
13	provided that, while in operation, any operator and passenger of		
14	an all-te	rrain vehicle shall wear a safety helmet with a	
15	securely fastened chin strap that meets the specifications and		
16	requireme	nts established by rules adopted by the director.	
17	(b)	For purposes of this section:	
18	"All	-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:

7	(5)	Has a single seat designed to be straddled by the
