## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE ENTERPRISE ZONES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that sustainable business
- 2 corporations engaged in the development or production of
- 3 renewable energy will stimulate business, agricultural, and
- industrial growth in areas that will result in neighborhood 4
- 5 revitalization. The addition of other forms of renewable
- 6 resources to the state enterprise zone program is consistent
- with currently approved business activities, which include wind 7
- 8 energy production. State enterprise zone tax incentives and
- regulatory flexibility will help attract renewable energy 9
- businesses and further the State's renewable energy goals. 10
- The purpose of this Act is to expand eligible business 11
- 12 activity in the state enterprise zones to include the
- 13 development or production of various types of renewable energy
- 14 by sustainable business corporations.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 209E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- amended by amending the definition of "eligible business 16
- activity" to read as follows: 17
- 18 ""Eligible business activity" means the:

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1	(1)	Manufacture of tangible personal property, the
2		wholesale sale of tangible personal property as
3		described in section 237-4, or a service business as
4		defined in this section;
5	(2)	Production of agricultural products where the business
6		is a producer as defined in section 237-5, or the
7		processing of agricultural products, all or some of
8		which were grown within an enterprise zone;
9	(3)	Research, development, sale, or production of all
10		types of genetically-engineered medical, agricultural,
11		or maritime biotechnology products; [or]
12	(4)	Production of electric power from wind energy for sale
13		primarily to a public utility company for resale to
14		the public[-]; or
15	(5)	Development, production, or energy storage by a
16		sustainable business corporation, as defined in
17		section 420D-2, of fuels, thermal energy, or
18		electrical energy from renewable resources, including:
19		(A) Wind;
20		(B) The sun;
21		(C) Falling water;

1	<u>(D)</u>	Biogas, including landfill and sewage-based
2		digester gas;
3	<u>(E)</u>	<pre>Geothermal;</pre>
4	<u>(F)</u>	Ocean water, currents, and waves, including ocean
5		thermal energy conversion;
6	(G)	Biomass, including biomass crops, agriculture and
7		animal residues and wastes, and solid waste;
8	<u>(H)</u>	Biofuels; and
9	<u>(I)</u>	Hydrogen produced from renewable energy sources."
10	SECTION 3	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 4	. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
