A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Article XVII, section 2, of the Constitution of 2 the State of Hawaii provides that the legislature may submit to 3 the electorate at any general or special election the question, "Shall there be a convention to propose a revision of or 4 5 amendments to the Constitution?" 6 The purpose of this Act is to provide for the submission of 7 the question to be placed on the ballot at the general election 8 of 2014. 9 SECTION 2. The question to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows: 10 "Shall there be a convention to propose a revision of or 11 amendments to the Constitution?" 12 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 14
