### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 92F-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "§92F-13 Government records; exceptions to general rule. 3 This part shall not require disclosure of: 4 (1) Government records which, if disclosed, would 5 6 constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal 7 privacy; 8 (2) Government records pertaining to the prosecution or defense of any judicial or quasi-judicial action to 9 10 which the State or any county is or may be a party, to 11 the extent that such records would not be discoverable: 12 (3) Government records that, by their nature, must be 13 confidential in order for the government to avoid the 14 15 frustration of a legitimate government function; 16 Government records which, pursuant to state or federal (4)17 law including an order of any state or federal court, 18 are protected from disclosure; [and]

PURPOSE:

Protects the sensitive content of

homestead application files and homestead lease files by including these government records as examples of government records

in which are not required to be

disclosed.

MEANS:

Amend section 92F-13, Hawaii Revised

Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION:

The department has recently received UIPA requests for specific homestead application files and homestead lease files that include personal contact information, genealogies, finance and loan documents, and other correspondence. The disclosure of these records constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Hawaii Administrative Rules Title 10 further requires that "Personal data received or recorded by the department shall be held in absolute confidence and no release of information shall be made without written approval of the individual concerned."

Impact on the public: This proposal further protects the interest of Hawaiian home land beneficiaries and their successors by protecting information in which they have a significant privacy interest.
