## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMPLIANCE WITH THE HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
- 2 health is considered a covered entity for purposes of compliance
- 3 with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of
- 4 1996 (HIPAA), and as such is required to designate: (1) a
- 5 privacy official responsible for the development and
- 6 implementation of privacy-related policies and procedures as
- 7 provided in title 45 Code of Federal Regulations section
- 8 164.530(a)(1); and (2) a security official responsible for
- 9 coordinating information security compliance as provided in
- 10 title 45 Code of Federal Regulations section 164.308(a)(2).
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to promote compliance with
- 12 information privacy and security provisions of HIPAA and the
- 13 related HIPAA privacy rule and HIPAA security rule.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 16 and to read as follows:

1	"§321- Information privacy and security; federal
2	compliance. The department of health shall establish the
3	following permanent or temporary positions for the purpose of
4	department compliance with federal information privacy and
5	security rules:
6	(1) Privacy officer; and
7	(2) Security officer.
8	The positions shall be appointed by the director without regard
9	to chapter 76."
10	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
