A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION MANAGEMENT OFFICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the quality of the
- 2 environment is as important to the welfare of the people of
- 3 Hawaii as is the economy of the State. The legislature finds
- 4 that there is increasing demand for the collection and
- 5 dissemination of state environmental data to the public, to the
- 6 regulated and permitted community, and to the United States
- 7 Environmental Protection Agency. The legislature also finds
- 8 that the development of specialized environmental information
- 9 management systems can greatly assist the department of health's
- 10 environmental health administration to provide timely and
- 11 comprehensive environmental information to the public, increase
- 12 efficiency, and make more informed decisions to better protect
- 13 the environment. The legislature finds that an environmental
- 14 information management office needs to be established to more
- 15 efficiently and effectively collect and disseminate
- 16 environmental data. This in turn will greatly assist the
- 17 environmental programs to make better decisions through the

- 1 development of enhanced software programs. In order to maintain
- 2 current successful software systems, as well as continue to
- 3 develop new ones, the legislature finds that the environmental
- 4 information management office should be created in the
- 5 department of health.
- 6 SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
- 7 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 "CHAPTER
- 10 ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION MANAGEMENT OFFICE
- 11 § -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the
- 12 context otherwise requires:
- "Department" means the department of health.
- "Director" means the director of health.
- "Manager" means the manager of the environmental
- 16 information management office.
- "Office" means the environmental information management
- **18** office established in section -2.
- 19 § -2 Environmental information management office;
- 20 establishment. There is established an environmental
- 21 information management office that shall be headed by a single
- 22 executive to be known as the manager of environmental

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information	management	who	shall	be	appointed	bv	the	director

- 2 without regard to chapter 76. The manager may hire staff, as
- 3 may be necessary, without regard to chapter 76. The office
- 4 shall implement this chapter and shall be placed within the
- 5 department of health. The office shall perform its duties under
- 6 this chapter and shall serve the director in an advisory
- 7 capacity on all matters relating to environmental information
- 8 management.
- 9 S -3 Duties. The office shall:
- 10 (1) Promote the use of environmental information systems
- and new management innovations such as mobile
- 12 applications that enable efficient and non-duplicative
- 13 collection and dissemination of environmental data for
- the department's environmental programs, the
- department, the State, and the public;
- 16 (2) Provide effective project management to design,
- develop, and implement useful and relevant
- 19 (3) Develop and implement environmental information
- 20 management policy, in accordance with policy set by
- the chief information officer, the department, and the

1		United States Environmental Protection Agency for
2		environmental health programs within the department;
3	(4)	Seek partnerships and funding opportunities with
4		outside entities to develop and collaborate on new
5		environmental information management systems and to
6		enhance current environmental information management
7		systems; and
8	(5)	Promote the federal impetus for environmental programs
9		to reduce the burden of regulatory reporting
10		processes, increase efficiencies in data reporting and
11		accessibility, and facilitate effective coordination
12		of environmental regulatory data functions."
13	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
