A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
- 5 appropriation to provide funds for the functions of the Hawaii
- 6 health systems corporation and its regions. Without an
- 7 emergency appropriation, the Hawaii health systems corporation's
- 8 health care operations will be severely impacted, placing health
- 9 care of the residents and visitors of the State in jeopardy.
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2013-2014 for the
- 13 purpose of supporting the functions of the Hawaii health systems
- 14 corporation.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii health
- 16 systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
