A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 171-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§171-4 Board of land and natural resources; terms and qualifications of members of the board; organization; expenses. 4 The board of land and natural resources shall be composed 5 (a) 6 of seven members, one from each land district and three at 7 large, to be nominated and, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, appointed by the governor as provided in section 8 9 26-34. The term and removal of a member of the board and the 10 filling of a vacancy on the board shall also be as provided in section 26-34. There shall be not more than three members on 11 12 the board from the same political party. At least one member of 13 the board shall have a background in conservation and natural 14 resources, as evidenced by:

15 (1) A college degree in a relevant field, including
16 forestry, wildlife conservation, geology,
17 environmental science, or marine biology; or



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1	(2)	Work history sufficient to demonstrate an appropriate
2		level of knowledge in the subject of land and natural
3		resources, including parks and recreation, public
4		lands management, natural area reserves, aquatic
5		resources, boating and recreation, forestry and
6		wildlife, water resources management, or conservation
7		and resources.
8	<u>(b)</u>	At least one member of the board, other than the
9	member wi	th a background in conservation and natural resources
10	appointed	pursuant to subsection (a), shall have demonstrated
11	expertise	in native Hawaiian traditional and customary
12	practices	, as evidenced by:
13	(1)	A college degree in a relevant field, such as Hawaiian
14		studies, native Hawaiian law, native Hawaiian
15		traditional and customary practices, or a related
16		subject area;
17	(2)	Work history that demonstrates an appropriate level of
18		knowledge in native Hawaiian traditional and customary
19		practices; or
20	<u>(3)</u>	Substantial experience in native Hawaiian traditional
21		and customary practices.
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1 [(b)] (c) Each member shall disclose and file with the 2 board a list of all transactions with the department of land and 3 natural resources in which the member has a direct interest. 4 The member shall also disclose all transactions with the 5 department involving any corporation, association, partnership, 6 or joint venture in which the member is an officer, partner, or 7 employee. Any member having any interest, direct or indirect, 8 in any matter before the board shall disqualify oneself from 9 voting on or participating in the discussion of the matter. 10 [(c)] (d) The governor shall select a chairperson of the 11 board from among its members. The chairperson shall call and 12 preside at meetings and may appoint a member of the board as 13 secretary. The members of the board shall choose one of their 14 number to act as chairperson during the absence or disability of 15 the chairperson.

16 [-(d)-] (e) The members of the board shall serve without pay 17 but shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses 18 while attending meetings and while in the discharge of their 19 duties."

3 SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect4 on July 1, 2014.

Report Title:

Board of Land and Natural Resources Membership; Native Hawaiian Traditional and Customary Practices

Description:

Amends the composition of the Board of Land and Natural Resources by requiring that at least one member shall have a background in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices, who shall not be the same member with a background in conservation and natural resources. (SB2874 HD1)

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
