A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TUNA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§32</u>	Tuna treated with carbon monoxide; labeling;
5	expiration	n. (a) Beginning on January 1, 2015, all tuna and
6	tuna prodi	ucts treated with carbon monoxide offered for retail
7	sale with	in the State of Hawaii are misbranded if the fact is
8	not disclosed as follows:	
9	(1)	In the case of raw tuna or a raw tuna product, on the
10		package offered for retail sale, with the words
11		"Treated With Carbon Monoxide" appearing clearly and
12		conspicuously on the label on the front of the
13		package, or in the case of any such product that is
14		not separately packaged or labeled, on a clear and
15		conspicuous label appearing on the retail store shelf
16		or bin in which such product is displayed for sale;
17	(2)	In the case of processed food containing some tuna
18		treated with carbon monoxide, the manufacturer shall

1		label the product in clear and conspicuous language on
2		the front or back of the package of such food, with
3		the words "Produced With Tuna Treated with Carbon
4		Monoxide"; and
5	(3)	Any word, statement, or other information appearing on
6		a label upon or connected to the immediate container
7		or surface of any product containing tuna treated with
8		carbon monoxide shall not be considered to be in
9		compliance with this section unless such word,
10		statement, or other information also appears on the
11		outside container or wrapper, if any, of the bulk,
12		wholesale, or retail package of such product or is
13	٠.	easily legible through the outside container or
14		wrapper.
15	(b)	Beginning on January 1, 2015, any tuna or tuna product
16	that has	been treated with carbon monoxide shall be disposed of
17	if it is	not sold within ninety days after the earliest known
18	date that	the tuna was caught, purchased at wholesale, or
19	purchased	for resale.
20	(c)	Any violation of this section shall be considered a
21	violation	of section 328-6."
