### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAYS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the establishment of
- 2 a highway patrol is essential to increase the enforcement of the
- 3 statewide traffic code and related county ordinances,
- 4 particularly with regard to speeding and driving under the
- 5 influence of an intoxicant. To this end, public safety would be
- 6 improved by allowing the sheriff division of the department of
- 7 public safety to serve as a state highway patrol to handle
- 8 traffic violations on state roadways.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to establish a highway patrol
- 10 within the sheriff division of the department of public safety
- 11 that will contract with county police departments to operate the
- 12 highway patrol and enforce all traffic laws and other applicable
- 13 laws of the State and counties.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 16 and to read as follows:
- 17 "\$353C- Highway patrol. (a) There shall be established
- 18 within the sheriff division of the department a state highway

- patrol, which shall consist of state law enforcement officers 1
- 2 appointed by the sheriff.
- 3 (b) The state highway patrol established under this
- section shall enforce all of the traffic laws of the State under 4
- title 17 and county ordinances. The director, in consultation 5
- with the sheriff and the police chief of each county, shall 6
- 7 provide, by rule, for a listing of the statutes and ordinances
- within the jurisdiction of the state highway patrol. 8
- (c) The director shall enter into a contract with the 9
- 10 police chief of each county to operate the highway patrol and
- 11 implement the purposes of this section. The director, in
- consultation with the sheriff, shall coordinate responsibilities 12
- for traffic enforcement between the highway patrol and county 13
- police officers." 14
- SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 15
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 16 or so
- much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for 17
- the establishment of a state highway patrol within the sheriff 18
- 19 division of the department of public safety.
- 20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 21 public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 22
