A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the needs and
- 2 enrollment in Hawaii's public schools have shifted and changed
- 3 over time. Many schools are at capacity and do not have the
- 4 facilities to adequately handle continued growth, while others
- 5 struggle to find space to deliver needed programs and services.
- 6 While the department of education is currently addressing these
- 7 concerns through the construction of portable classrooms and
- 8 multi-track schools, the need to procure the lowest responsive,
- ${f 9}$ responsible bidder results in the department of education
- 10 contracting with many different contractors. This creates
- 11 inefficiencies and inconsistencies among public school campuses
- 12 in the timeliness of receiving portables, as well as in the
- 13 design and quality of such portables.
- 14 Fourth generation modular design building systems, such as
- 15 the Sprout Space classrooms designed by the company
- 16 Perkins+Will, are designed to enhance student learning by
- 17 incorporating sustainable green building strategies that reduce

- 1 learning environments. Such modular design buildings also
- 2 provide flexibility in design and use.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to create a five-year pilot
- 4 project within the department of education to authorize the
- 5 department of education to contract for the design, planning,
- 6 and installation of fourth generation modular design buildings
- 7 to maximize resources and better meet the growing and changing
- 8 needs of Hawaii's public school campuses.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) There is established within the department
- 10 of education a five-year fourth generation modular design
- 11 building pilot program.
- 12 (b) Under the pilot program, the department of education
- 13 shall enter into a multi-year contract for the design, planning,
- 14 and installation of fourth generation modular design buildings
- 15 on Hawaii's public school campuses.
- 16 (c) For purposes of this Act, the department of education
- 17 shall enter into a multi-year contract. The vendor shall be
- 18 selected by the most appropriate procurement method including
- 19 but not limited to sealed proposals, sealed bids, sole source,
- 20 or other procurement methods as permitted by chapter 103D,
- 21 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to specifically carry out the
- 22 requirements of the pilot project.



1	(d)	The department of education shall report to the
2	legislatu	re no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
3	the regul	ar session of 2015 and each regular session thereafter
4	until the	completion of the pilot project. The report shall
5	include:	
6	(1)	A summary of the department of education's efforts to
7		contract for the design, planning, purchasing, and
8		installation of fourth generation modular design
9		buildings;
10	(2)	A copy of the contract entered into pursuant to this
11		Act, if any;
12	(3)	The criteria used by the department of education in
13		selecting which public schools shall be part of the
14		<pre>pilot project;</pre>
15	(4)	A summary of any capacity and funding issues or
16		challenges the department of education has encountered
17		in carrying out the pilot project pursuant to this
18		Act;
19	(5)	A discussion of identified best practices as
20		determined through the pilot project, and goals for
21		system wide replication; and
22	(6)	Any proposed legislation.

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
- 4 the department of education to enter into a multi-year contract
- 5 for the design, planning, purchasing, and installation of fourth
- 6 generation modular design buildings on school campuses
- 7 throughout the State.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 education for the purposes of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Creates a five-year pilot project through which the department of education will contract for the design, planning, and installation of fourth generation modular design buildings on Hawaii's public school campuses.
