

1 (B) Scrips, tickets, or tokens that may be redeemed
2 for coins or currency;
3 provided that the term does not apply to change machines or
4 vending machines that in their normal operation do not dispense
5 more cash than was inserted for any single transaction or to any
6 automated teller machine.

7 "Monetary payout" means coins or currency dispensed as a
8 result of a transaction and includes scrips, tickets, or tokens
9 that may be redeemed for coins or currency. The term does not
10 include scrips, tickets, or tokens that can only be redeemed for
11 merchandise or playing time on games, unless the merchandise or
12 playing time may also be redeemed for coins or currency.

13 "Transaction" means a sequence of events initiated by
14 inserting one or more coins or tokens or any currency into a
15 device and culminating in a monetary payout.

16 (d) The owner of a commercial establishment shall be fined
17 \$2,500 for each device that is located at the establishment and
18 in violation of this section. The attorney general may bring a
19 civil action to enforce this section."

20 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
21 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
22 begun before its effective date.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Commercial Establishments; Prohibition on Devices with Monetary Payouts

Prohibits devices that allow monetary payouts that may be less than, equal to, or greater than the amount paid into the device, in any commercial establishment. Exempts change machines, vending machines, and automated teller machines.
