## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-195, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$291C-195 Driving of mopeds. (a) No person less than
- 4 [fifteen] eighteen years of age shall drive a moped on a
- 5 highway, street, roadway, or any other public property in the
- 6 State.
- 7 (b) No person [less than eighteen years of age] shall
- 8 drive a moped unless the person wears a safety helmet securely
- 9 fastened with a chin strap. The safety helmet shall meet the
- 10 specifications and requirements established by rules adopted by
- 11 the director.
- 12 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (c) No person shall drive a moped except while
- 13 sitting astride the seat, facing forward, with one leg on each
- 14 side of the moped.
- 15 [<del>(c)</del>] (d) No person shall drive a moped which is carrying
- 16 any other person nor shall any person other than the driver ride
- 17 upon a moped.

- 1 [(d)] (e) Subsections (b) and (c) shall not apply to
- 2 three-wheeled mopeds designed to carry a driver and passenger
- 3 seated side by side.
- 4 [<del>(e)</del>] (f) Three-wheeled mopeds shall be insured for
- 5 liability and property damage, excluding personal injury
- 6 protection."
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 9 begun before its effective date.
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
