## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARINE RESOURCES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the marine life
- 2 conservation program embodied in chapter 190, Hawaii Revised
- 3 Statutes, has preserved some of the State's most ecologically,
- economically, and scientifically valuable environmental assets. 4
- 5 The broad range of documented anthropogenic impacts on coral reef
- 6 health, including impacts from groundings, diving activities,
- 7 poaching, anchoring and mooring, land and water-based pollutant
- 8 discharges, and other direct and indirect uses of the State's
- 9 coral reefs, indicate that the department of land and natural
- 10 resources may need a more consistent and reliable source of
- 11 funding to maintain these unique areas and to conserve and
- 12 protect coral reef resources throughout the State.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to provide for a special fund
- 14 allowing for the collection and use of moneys for the
- conservation, supplementation, and enhancement of the State's 15
- coral reefs and other marine resources. 16
- 17 SECTION 2. Chapter 190, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 18 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 19 and to read as follows:

17	<u>(c)</u>	Subject to subsection (d), the coral reef and marine
18	life cons	ervation special fund shall be used for expenditures to:
19	(1)	Fulfill the purposes of this chapter, including marine
20		life conservation district monitoring, research,
21	•	regulatory measures, enforcement actions, educational
22		activities, or any other measure intended to conserve,
23		supplement, and enhance the resources within any marine

1		life conservation district established under this	
2		chapter or rules adopted pursuant to this chapter;	
3	<u>(2)</u>	Provide management, monitoring, and support for public	
4		fishing areas, community-based subsistence fishing	
5		areas, fisheries management areas, and other areas of	
6		<pre>localized management;</pre>	
7	<u>(3)</u>	Develop and carry out any compensatory mitigation	
8		measures for impacts to the marine environment,	
9		including impacts to the marine environment from	
10		federal or state permitted actions, or violations of	
1		this chapter or any rule adopted pursuant to this	
2		chapter; and	
3	<u>(4)</u>	Develop and carry out research projects, educational	
4		programs, management initiatives, and any other	
5		activity intended to conserve, supplement, and enhance	
6		the marine environment throughout the State.	
7	<u>(d)</u>	The coral reef and marine life conservation special	
8	fund shal	l be held separate and apart from all other moneys,	
9	funds, and accounts of the department of land and natural		
20	resources; provided that any moneys received from the federal		
1	government, through federal programs, or from private		
22	contributions shall be deposited and accounted for in accordance		
3	with conditions established by the agency or entity from which		
4	the moneys are received.		
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- 1 Any balance remaining in the fund at the end of any fiscal year
- 2 shall be carried forward in the fund for the next fiscal year.
- 3 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
