A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that erosion on the north
- 2 shore of Oahu is a health and safety issue that poses a
- 3 widespread threat to property and life. One immediate method to
- 4 ameliorate the danger is to realign Kamehameha highway to keep
- 5 traffic and people out of harm's way.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the issuance of
- 7 general obligation bonds and appropriate funds to the department
- 8 of transportation to realign Kamehameha highway mauka of
- 9 Laniakea beach on the north shore of Oahu.
- 10 SECTION 2. The department of transportation shall plan and
- 11 construct the realignment of Kamehameha highway mauka of
- 12 Laniakea beach, Oahu; provided that the realignment, if
- 13 necessary, shall be resilient and adaptive to rising sea levels
- 14 and coastal erosion that result from climate change.
- 15 SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 16 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015 to SB3035 HD1 HMS 2014-2508



- 1 plan and construct the realignment of Kamehameha highway mauka
- 2 of Laniakea beach on the north shore of Oahu.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
- 6 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
- 7 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
- 8 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 9 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
