A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$16,000,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 seventeenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the department of education:

8 A. Waipahu high school

9 Design, planning, and construction
10 of school-wide electrical upgrade;
11 ground and site improvements;
12 equipment and appurtenances.

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
12 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
13 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
14 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
15 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
17 projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
18 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
