BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the necessity to
- 2 ensure the safety of children by reducing the proximity of
- 3 registered sexual offenders to public and private schools and
- 4 public parks or recreation grounds.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 846E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- $\mathbf{6}$ amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 7 and to read as follows:
- 8 "§846E- (1) A covered offender required to register under
- 9 this chapter, upon initial registration or subsequent change of
- 10 address, who knowingly resides within three hundred feet of any
- 11 public or private school, kindergarten, preschool, public park
- or recreation ground shall be guilty of a class C felony."
- (2) For the purposes of this section:
- "Public park or recreational ground" means any state,
- 15 county or city designated park, public playground and public
- swimming pool.
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
