# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MAALAEA SMALL BOAT HARBOR.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the heavily-used  
2 Maalaea small boat harbor on Maui serves as a vital connection  
3 to recreational and commercial ocean activities. Therefore, it  
4 is important to keep this small boat harbor in good working  
5 condition. However, the finger piers located along the south  
6 mole at Maalaea small boat harbor are badly deteriorated and  
7 beyond repair. The legislature finds that replacement of the  
8 wooden finger piers is necessary to ensure the continued support  
9 of the commercial operators who use and depend on access to the  
10 Maalaea small boat harbor.

11       Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate  
12 \$           for the capital improvement project along the south  
13 mole at Maalaea small boat harbor on Maui.

14       SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
15 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$           or so much  
16 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
17 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015



1 for the purpose of the capital improvement project at Maalaea  
2 small boat harbor on Maui, as follows:

3 Replacement of wooden finger piers along the south mole at  
4 Maalaea small boat harbor, including the demolition of the  
5 existing piers and steel piles, installation of new  
6 aluminum framed piers, and new composite plastic fingering.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
11 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital  
13 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
14 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
15 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
