A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that increased
- 2 environmental harm might result from plastic bags that are
- 3 marketed or promoted as "biodegradable", "degradable", or
- 4 "compostable" but that do not meet the appropriate standard or
- 5 specification because consumers may be more cavalier in their
- 6 use of plastic bags on or near the ocean or other natural
- 7 environments if they mistakenly believe that these products will
- 8 meet their expectations for "biodegradable", "degradable", or
- 9 "compostable". Industry usage of those terms differs
- 10 drastically from consumer expectations of those terms.
- 11 The legislature further finds that the ASTM International
- 12 and the European Committee for Standardization issue globally
- 13 recognized standards or specifications. In 2011, ASTM
- 14 International withdrew ASTM D 6002, which many plastic
- 15 manufacturers had used to lend credibility to plastic bags that
- 16 were labeled as compostable. That standard has not yet been
- 17 replaced.



- 1 The purpose of this Act is to prevent the sale in bulk of 2 any plastic bag advertised, labeled, marked, marketed, or 3 promoted as "biodegradable", "degradable", or "compostable" 4 unless the department of health determines that such products 5 meet the appropriate ASTM International standard specification 6 or European Committee for Standardization standard as adopted by 7 the department. 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 342H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 10 to read as follows: PLASTIC BAG LABELING 11 "PART 12 Definitions. As used in this part, unless the §342H-
- context otherwise requires: "Biodegradable" means able to meet the ASTM International 14 standard specification or European Committee for Standardization 15 16 standard that has been adopted by the department for 17 biodegradability.
- "Compostable" means able to meet the ASTM International 18 19 standard specification or European Committee for Standardization 20 standard that has been adopted by the department for 21 compostability.

- 1 "Degradable" means able to meet the ASTM International
- 2 standard specification or European Committee for Standardization
- 3 standard that has been adopted by the department for
- 4 degradability.
- 5 "Plastic bag" means a bag made out of or containing high-
- 6 density polyethylene or other petroleum-derived plastic, even if
- 7 the bag contains other materials.
- 8 "Sell in bulk" means to sell one hundred or more plastic
- 9 bags in one sale or one thousand or more plastic bags in
- 10 aggregate sales in one year.
- 11 §342H- Adoption of standards. The department shall
- 12 adopt ASTM International standard specifications or European
- 13 Committee for Standardization standards for biodegradable,
- 14 compostable, and degradable if and when the department deems
- 15 such specifications or standards to be appropriate or suitable
- 16 for plastic bags.
- 17 §342H- Verification. Any person wishing to sell in bulk
- 18 any plastic bag advertised, labeled, marked, marketed, or
- 19 promoted as "biodegradable", "degradable", or "compostable"
- 20 shall first check with the department if the appropriate
- 21 specification or standard has been adopted by the department and
- 22 apply to the department for verification that its plastic bag

meets the specification or standard adopted by the department. 1 2 The applicant shall provide the department with any information requested by the department and shall pay for any testing deemed 3 4 necessary by the department. **Prohibition.** After December 31, 2014, no person 5 S342Hshall sell in bulk any plastic bag advertised, labeled, marked, 6 marketed, or promoted as "biodegradable", "degradable", or 7 8 "compostable" unless: The department has adopted the appropriate 9 (1)10 specification or standard; and The department has verified that the person's plastic 11 (2) bags meet the adopted specification or standard. 12 Fines. Violators shall be fined: 13 14 (1)\$100 plus \$1 for each bag sold for the first violation; 15 \$500 plus \$5 for each bag sold for the second 16 (2) **17** violation; and 18 (3) \$1,000 plus \$10 for each bag sold for the third and subsequent violations." 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 20
