A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the following sums or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sums or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary are appropriated for fiscal year
5 2014-2015 for the purpose of financing capital improvement
6 projects for the fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the department of education:

8 A. Aiea intermediate school

9 Design, construction, and

10 equipment for expansion of band

11 room; ground and site

12 improvements; equipment; and

13 appurtenances.

21 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
22 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at



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1 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
2 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
3 unencumbered as of June 30, 2017, shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
5 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
6 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
7 this Act.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
