BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 8-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:

4	second Monday in October shall be known as [Discoverers']	
5	<u>Indigenous Peoples'</u> Day, in recognition of the:	
6	(1)	Polynesian [discoverers] founders of the Hawaiian

8	(2)	Accomplishments of the indigenous voyagers who founded
9		and settled the myriad islands of the Pacific ocean
10		more than one thousand years before Christopher
11		Columbus was born; and
12	(3)	Countless indigenous peoples who perished worldwide as
13		a result of confrontations between indigenous peoples
14		and Europeans, along with the survival of their

16	This day shall serve as a day to educate the general public on	
17	the State of Hawaii's obligations to the Native peoples of	
18	Hawaii, including the State's continued protection of all rights
